



School rules and regulations

OBEDIENCE TO SCHOOL AUTHORITY

Pupils must obey all school authority (*Ephesians 6:1-3; Isaiah 1:19*)

1. Undermining Authority: This includes teaching and non-teaching staff, pupil leaders is defined in the following terms: -

Abusing/insulting (use of abusive language) punishable with a two-day internal suspension with manual work and counseled.

Failure to comply with the punishment will lead to a two-week suspension from school and return with a parent/guardian.

2. Refusal to perform / do task assigned by authority.
Punishment; a two-week suspension from school and return with a parent/guardian.

3. Fighting/threatening to fight authority.
Punishment is immediate indefinite suspension from school.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All pupils must be in School Uniform during class time, to Church, any other School function, and when leaving or coming back to school. (*Deuteronomy 22:11*)

1. Pupils shall not be allowed to bring in any casual wear; instead they shall bring three Red T-shirts and 3 black skirts/Trousers for out of class use.

2. Pupils are prohibited from wearing earrings, caps, hats and necklaces. Hair must be kept simple, short and tidy (1 Peter 3:3-4, Exodus 32:3-4; Isaiah 3:16-21)

3. Slippers and open shoes are not allowed in classrooms during class time.

A pupil who reports to school not in a proper school uniform will not be allowed entry into the school.

Ear rings/pins, hats, caps, necklaces, bangles, once found will be confiscated for good.

Any unauthorized casual wear found in the pupil's possession will be confiscated for good.

A pupil found with long hair, nails and painted nails shall be asked to cut them off and clean off the painted nails immediately. Failure to do so, rule number 1(a) subsection (ii) will apply.

Slippers and open shoes once found with a pupil during class time will be confiscated for good.

Abuse of the school uniform i.e. folding of sleeves, not tucking in, no tie, loosened tie, tampering with the uniform design, failure to put on stockings/rolled down stockings, e.t.c. will lead to a one-day internal suspension with manual work

VISITATION DAY

1. The Visitation Days will be once every term between 07:00 a.m – 6:00 p.m strictly.
2. Every parent/Guardian will be expected to get a visitation card from the school, to always be presented before seeing a child.

Pupils will not be allowed to receive visitors on any other day other than the official visitor's day. In cases of emergencies, the Parent/Guardian should report to the Office for help.

Pupils will not be allowed to receive visitors without valid visitation cards.

Parents/Guardians who carry cooked food shall have their children/child sent home for a one-week suspension and return with the parent/guardian.

Visitors without official permission are not allowed in the dormitories. Once found, the pupil visited shall be treated as in rule no. 3 subsection

CLASS ATTENDANCE

Class attendance is compulsory to **ALL** the Pupils; Pupils must be diligent at their class work too.

A pupil who misses a lesson/ prep/ test without a valid reason(s) will be asked to bring a parent/guardian and sign a commitment.

A pupil who persistently misses lessons/ preps/ tests will be sent home for a one-week suspension and return with a parent/ guardian to sign a last warning letter. However, if the habit continues without valid reasons, the pupil will be indefinitely suspended.

Maximum silence shall be observed during ALL study time. Unnecessary noise making during study times will lead to a day's internal suspension from class with manual work to the culprits

The official language of use on the School compound is the English language.

ESCAPING FROM SCHOOL

1st time a pupil is caught; he/she will buy a roll of barbed wires, then go for a suspension for one week and reports back with a parent. After which a pupil will make a statement promising never to repeat the offence.

2nd offence will lead to automatic expulsion.

ELECTRONIC GADGETS

Electronic gadgets such as Mobile Phones, Radios and such related gadgets are not allowed in the school.

A pupil found in possession of the above gadgets will have them confiscated for good and will be given a two-weeks suspension to return with a parent /Guardian.

If the pupil is found again in possession of such items, he/she will be indefinitely suspended from school.

INTOXICANTS

The use and possession of intoxicants such as Cocaine, Marijuana, Cigarettes, Alcoholic drinks and ALL sorts of drugs are prohibited in the school (**Proverbs 23:21; 1 Corinthians 5:11; 1 Corinthians 6:10; Ephesians 5:18**).

Once found, will lead to the immediate expulsion of the pupil.

BULLYING AND TEASING

Bullying and Teasing, or any other unbecoming conduct will lead to immediate expulsion.

RELATIONSHIPS

Un-healthy boy-girl relationship is prohibited in the school. This is punishable by immediate expulsion.

FIGHTING IN THE SCHOOL

A pupil involved in such an act will immediately be expelled.

EXAMINATIONS

Pupils caught in any form of examination mal practice, shall be terminated from the paper in progress immediately and once found guilty, will be indefinitely suspended from school.

A pupil who misses a lesson/ prep/ test without a valid reason(s) will be asked to bring a parent/ guardian and sign a commitment.

Deliberate missing of exams without valid reasons will lead to indefinite suspension from school.

Unnecessary movements in and around an examination session will lead to cancellation of the examination in progress for that particular pupil(s).

ABUSE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

The pupil will be expected to pay for whatsoever damage incurred, including buying new textbooks, laboratory “equipment, e.t.c in two fold.

USE OF ABUSIVE AND VULGAR LANGUAGE

Pupils caught in any form of examination mal practice, shall be terminated from the paper in progress immediately and once found guilty, will be indefinitely suspended from school.

1st Offence he/she will be assigned to wash the toilets for a week and counseled accordingly.

2nd Offence, the pupil will serve a one weeks' suspension.

3rd Offence will lead to immediate expulsion from school.

THEFT

1st Offence, if proved guilty, the pupil will have to pay two fold of the stolen property and suspended for a week.

1st Offence he/she will be assigned to wash the toilets for a week and counseled accordingly.

2nd Offence, the pupil will immediately be expelled from School.
